

WHAT TO EXPECT

Sunday Morning KidsWay

Check-In

Check-in will take place at the north entrance of Linwood. All children (birth through 5th grade) will check-in via touchless check-in at this station. Check-in will be expedited by downloading the Church Center app. All leaders and participants will have their temperatures checked and hands sanitized before entering the KidsWay environments. (Please see Sick Policy for details of entry). All KidsWay participants, birth through 5th grade, must have a check in tag on their clothing prior to entering their room.

Masks

This is subject to change as social distancing requirements and church guidelines change.



When Masks Are Strongly Recommended to be Worn

- All participants and leaders are strongly recommended to wear masks while entering the building until they reach their seating in the KidsWay worship centers or classrooms.
- Masks are strongly recommended to be worn in hallway areas moving from large group to small group rooms.



When Masks Can be Removed

- When the participant or leader has reached their seating in the KidsWay worship centers.
- While participants and leaders are in their small group rooms. Social distancing should still be maintained.
- While in the gym, or outside on the playground. Social distancing practices should still be maintained as much as possible.

Nursery

Sanitation measures have been increased. Please understand that if you leave your child with us in the nursery that maintaining social distancing will not be possible. Babies and toddlers will be held and changed as necessary. Leaders will strongly recommended to wear masks while they are caring for children in the nursery.

You are welcome to bring a diaper bag as needed, but we ask that no outside toys be brought in at this time.

KidsWay (Preschool through 5th Grade)

KidsWay will meet in the large group room for the beginning portion of Sunday morning. Social distancing will be attempted, but cannot be fully guaranteed.

Small groups are assigned as such:

- Pre-K: ages 3 (if fully potty trained) through 1st Grade
- 2nd - 5th Grades

Each child will be provided a pencil box that will include crayons, pencils and a pencil sharpener that will have their name on it and will remain in their classroom. A separate box will be provided that children can place their masks in while in the classroom to keep masks separated as needed.

Check-Out

Parents shall enter the building at the south entrance as with check in.

- Pick Up for KidsWay will be at the classroom doors. If weather allows, the children will be taken out to the playground if time allows during service. A note will be left on the door letting you know if the children have moved to the playground. Please maintain social distancing as you reach the door.
- Leaders will be verifying your security code to the students name badge, but will not be removing them from the children's clothing. Church Center gives you a digital pick up tag when you check your children in online so you don't have to keep track of the paper version.

Policy Changes

We all know that things can change quickly in this current season we are in. There may be changes that occur throughout this school year for the safety of our families and leaders. We will communicate changes as quickly as possible. Thank you for your grace and patience as we all maneuver this uncertain season together.

Sick Policy:



Stay home and try again next week if:

- Fever of 100.4 or higher within the last 48 hours
- Wheezing or shortness of breath
- Cough
- Constant runny nose
- Lethargy
- Vomiting or diarrhea within the last 48 hours
- Redness or Crusty Eyes
- Sore throat or swollen glands
- Undiagnosed rashes or persistent itching
- Head lice
- Uncovered sores
- Unusual color or just generally feeling unwell



Come in but take it easy if:

- Fever free for at least 48 hours without fever reducers
- Free from vomiting and diarrhea for at least 48 hours
- No live lice and nits have been removed
- Antibiotics must be in effect for at least 48 hours if prescribed
- Any other situations have been resolved
- Overall health seems to be positive



Come on in if:

- Active
- Playful
- Rested

What happens if your child gets sick while here?

If your child/student becomes sick during our care, we will separate them from the group and contact you immediately. Please pick up your child at the time designated by the leader. If we are unable to reach you, we will call the emergency contact number.
